2 Matters arising/Action updates

8 Treasurer's Report/ Charity Commission update

9 School/Parish Report & School Fundraising

The Parish Council has agreed to contribute towards the new kitchen, if the grant application is unsuccessful. Planned Lotus works have been delayed because of flooding. There will be a £5 increase in Band E council tax. The PC is objecting to the overhead pylon cabling. Planning application for Farthings is going in this month.
